Melissa was born in Scotland and attended dance, drama and singing classes from a young age. After second-

ary school, she completed a Higher National Diploma in Musical Theatre at The Glasgow Academy of Musical Theatre Arts in 2005. Melissa went on to train full-time at The Liverpool Institute for Performing Arts, gaining a BA (Hons) in Acting (Performing Arts).

Since leaving LIPA in 2008, she has worked professionally as an actor across the country. Acting credits since

graduating include Yitzhak in *Hedwig & The Angry Inch* with Lodestar Theatre Company, Agnes Sampson in *James* with Chester's Theatre In The Quarter, and Sarah/Rhoda in *Incubate Showcase* performed at Octagon Theatre in Bolton. Most recently, she performed in *A Jacobean Christmas* at Hampton Court in London.

Melissa began teaching a variety of acting techniques in 2009. She has taught for Little Actor's Theatre Company, Everyman & Playhouse Theatre and LIPA's Widening Participation programme. She has worked with young people from the age of two to young adults in further education.

Bucuresti is a new piece of musical theatre that is based on true stories about Romania's street children.

The LIPA 4:19 cast members performed alongside students on LIPA's undergraduate degree and Foundation Certificate courses.

The director and producers were

blown away with the talent and discipline of the LIPA 4:19 participants, who had to perform solo songs and acting lines.

Bucuresti tells of two sisters who escape poverty-stricken rural Romania and an alcoholic mother to seek a better life in Bucharest.

The music and lyrics are by second-year LIPA musician Monica Sik Holm. The musical debuted in Norway where it has raised £10,000 for charity and won musical theatre awards.

Former student Lauren part of new girl band


We are very proud of ex student Lauren Deegan, who beat off competition from thousands of hopefuls in 2010 to be part of new up and coming girl band Parade.

Shows: Friday 8 July 2011 and Saturday 9 July 2011

-Friday: 7pm. Arrive no later than 6pm. Finish time TBC.
-Saturday matinee: 3pm. Arrive no later than 2pm. Finish time TBC.

Tap students will be performing in the Sunday Academy show.

Technical rehearsal: Sunday 26 June.

- Register 2pm. Specialist classes will be finished around 4pm.

Dress rehearsal: Monday 4 July

- Register at 5pm. Finish time TBC.

Shows: Tuesday July 5 and Wednesday July 6

- Both start 7pm. Arrive no later than 6pm. Finish time TBC

Extra rehearsals

-Various classes and students will be required for extra rehearsals. These may start three weeks before the shows, on various evenings. We'll keep you informed about when these will take place.

Costumes

Some costumes will be made or bought for the show, but most classes will be required to provide costumes and accessories.

LIPA 4:19 uniform

Students are to wear their uniform for the technical rehearsals but not for the dress run and shows.

Tickets

We will announce, at a later date, as to when and how tickets can be purchased.

Finale rehearsals

Academy students (not Early Start) will be required to stay an extra half hour after their lessons for four weeks prior to the show. The dates are May 21, May 28, June 4, June 11.

Students are not required for Saturday classes after their shows.

All Early Start students open the show with their show piece; all Early Start students must be collected straight after they have performed.
