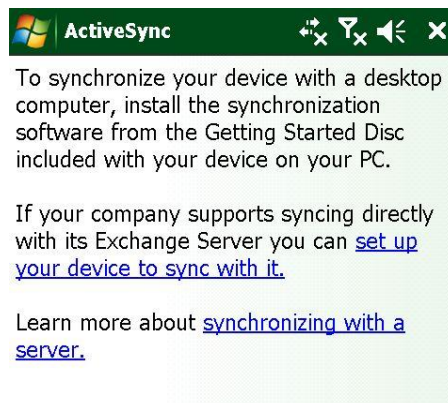


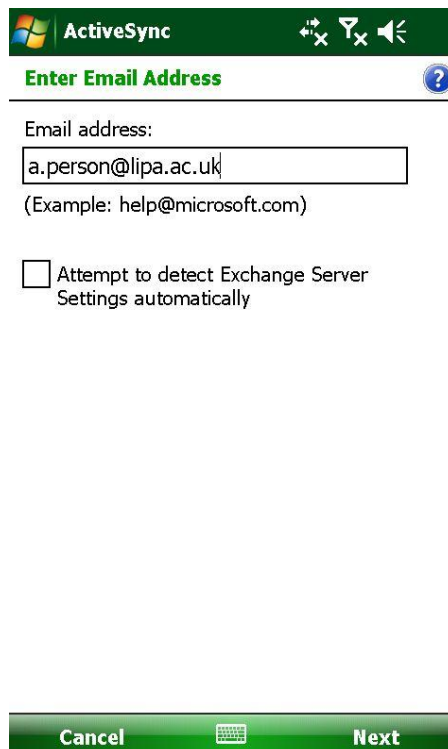
Connecting your Windows Mobile or Apple iPhone to the LIPA Push Email server

Windows Mobile 6.1

Click on 'set up your device to sync with it'



Type your email address into the box and un-tick the 'Attempt to detect Exchange Server Settings automatically'




Type the server address and tick the SSL check box.

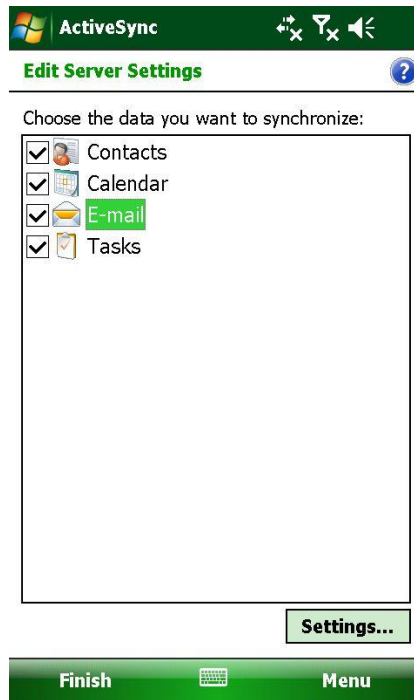
Type your LIPA Username, Password and Domain into the relevant boxes.



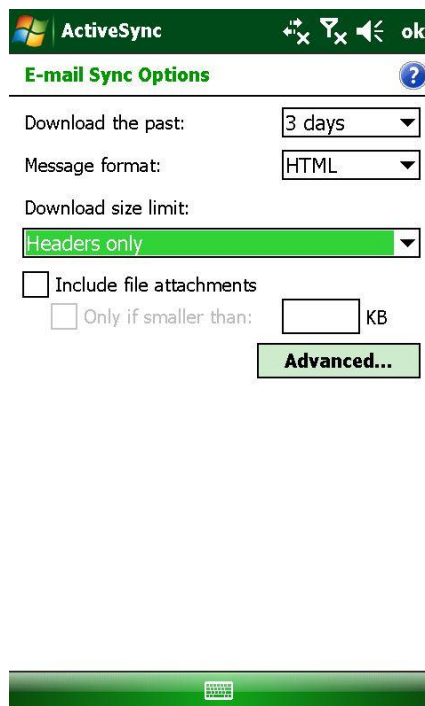

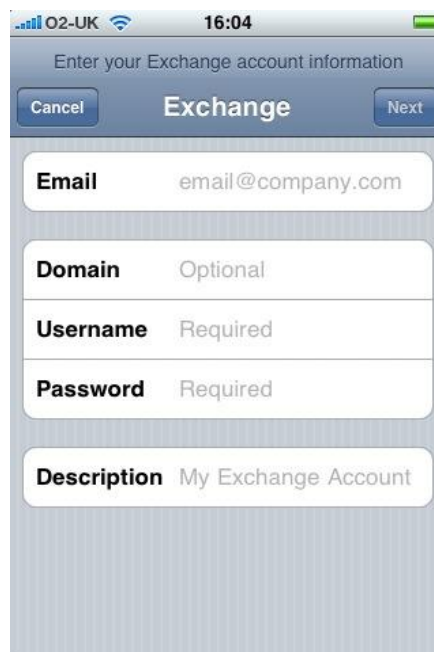
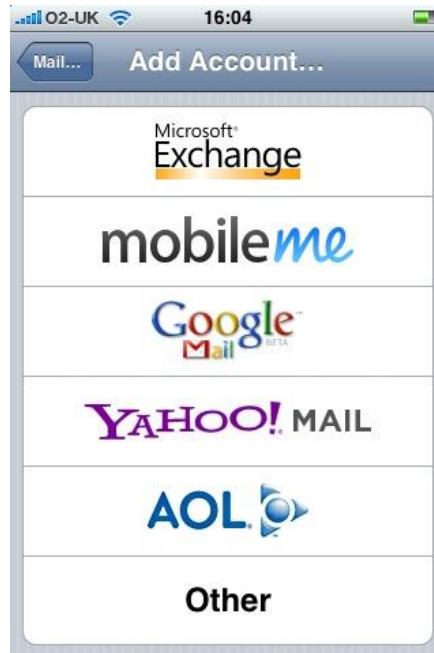
Tick the boxes for the data you want to synchronize, some items have extra settings such as 'E-mail' select E-mail and then press the 'Settings' button
